Mathias Peter Möller (commonly known as M.P. Möller) was a prolific Danish organ builder. He was a native of the Danish island of Bornholm. He founded the M.P. Möller Pipe Organ Company in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania in 1875. The city of Hagerstown took notice of Möller's early successes and induced him to move his business to that city to help make Hagerstown a viable business center in Western Maryland. The result was M. P. Möller, Inc. and the company remained in business until 1992, with a production of over 11,000 instruments.
